

Financial Verification for International Students ~ Undergraduate 2012-2013

United States government regulations require that certification of admission be based on both academic acceptance and evidence of adequate funds to meet all expenses for a student's proposed course of study.

This *Financial Verification for International Students* provides verification that the applicant, family, and/or sponsor is providing the necessary financial support, along with financial statements showing sufficient funds to cover the student's schooling and other expenses during their intended period of study.

Please provide documents to verify your financial declarations. Examples of supporting documents include: current bank statements, letter from employer stating length of employment, and tax documents showing yearly income. Students need to keep a duplicate set of documentation - necessary to apply for a student visa.

All documents should be in English (or provide English translation) with monetary amounts expressed in U.S. dollars. Complete this form in English and type or print neatly in ink.
