Concordia University, Nebraska Alumni Award Category Descriptions

Church Worker Alumnus of the Year Award –

An alumnus currently serving in or retired from a professional church work vocation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

Young Alumnus of the Year Award –

An alumnus who graduated within the last 15 years and has made a significant contribution as a servant leader in the community, church, and world.

Partners in Mission and Ministry Award –

Alumni currently serving in a mission field as partners or joint offices of professional church work or related vocations of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

Church Leadership in Outreach Award –

An alumnus currently serving in a unique or challenging ministry which reaches out to a new segment of a population for the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

Lay Worker of the Year Award –

An alumnus reflecting outstanding Christian leadership in congregation, community, and/or displays a dedicated commitment to their work as an arm of ministry.

Friend of Concordia Award –

An alumnus reflecting outstanding Christian leadership as a lay worker through exemplary service to Concordia, alumni advancement, student recruitment and/or university support and promotion.

Lifetime Service Award –

An alumnus or friend of Concordia who reflects outstanding Christian loyalty to support Concordia and the world through volunteer service.

Honorary Alumni Award –

A friend of Concordia who is not an alumnus, who supports Concordia by contributions of time, talent, financial and/or other gifts, a business and/or professional insight, etc.
