

NetLibrary eBooks

What are ebooks?

- eBooks are electronic versions of print books.
- eBooks can contain photos, illustrations, graphs and tables.
- Users can navigate through the text (e.g. easily search for specific passages) in ways not possible in print.

What is NetLibrary?

- NetLibrary is a commercial provider of online books (ebooks) in full-text.
- NetLibrary offers libraries access to a wide range of research, reference and reading materials online.

Requirements

- To access NetLibrary you need Internet access and a web browser. You must remain connected to the Internet while you read a book.
- NetLibrary requires Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.5 and above, Netscape Navigator 6.2 and above, Mozilla 1.1, Firebird .06 and above, Opera 7.x, or Camino 0.7 and above.

Accessing Link Library's NetLibrary collection

- You will find NetLibrary books listed in the library's catalog along with other material. The citation in a list looks like this:

Electronic access: [This is an electronic book accessible only through subscribing libraries: click here for information and access.](#)

- To access the book, click on the above line which is a hot link to a display of the book.
- You do not need a NetLibrary user account to search for or view ebooks from on campus. However, to view a book from off campus, you need an account.

How do I create an account? (It's free.)

1. First, using a workstation on campus or logging on from off campus, visit the NetLibrary web site at <http://www.netlibrary.com>.
2. Click on the "Create a Free Account" link located at the top right-hand side of the screen.
3. Fill out the account information.
4. Click on "Create Account."
5. If the username you entered is unavailable you will be asked to select a different username.
6. When your account is set up successfully it will return you to the Basic Search screen and display the message "Your account has been successfully created."
7. From now on use this username and password to view NetLibrary materials from off campus.

Searching for an ebook

You may limit your search to only ebooks by using the drop down menu to limit the type to "Electronic book" or the location field to "NetLibrary."
