Performing Arts Emphasis students can complete their major (37 to 44 hours) and a minor and still have more than 20 elective hours in their 128-credit program. A student might want to consider a second minor, depending on how many hours the student selects for this major. Performing arts students can complete their program in four years taking 32 credits per academic year. Courses are offered on a rotating basis refer to the 5 year course offerings for each area.

All degrees require at least 128 semester hours of credit with a minimum cumulative grade average of “C” (2.00) or the minimum grade average specified by individual program requirements (if higher). A minimum of 30 semester hours (12 of which must be on the 300 & 400 level and 15 of which must be in the student’s major) must be taken in residence.

A second bachelor’s degree requires an additional 30 semester hours above the 128 hours.
