

A common question is “What does flexibility in deadlines for assignments and/or projects mean?”

Flexibility in deadlines for assignments and/or projects:

- a. The professors set those parameters. As a student with this accommodation, know that "flexibility" is at the discretion of the professor. You need to communicate with your professor when you need an extension on an assignment/project. What is reasonable in terms of time is up to the professor.

For example, it is not reasonable for you to turn in all your assignments at the end of the module. Students should understand this without hesitation.

- b. You as the student are responsible for keeping track of continuance of deadlines and missing work. Your professor is not responsible for this.
- c. If at any time the professor believes that the student’s request for extensions on deadlines threatens the academic integrity of the curriculum or the accomplishment of the learning objectives, the professor should notify the student and me to review possible options.
