Effective for the 2023 – 2024 Catalog. Concordia University, Nebraska accepts up to 70 hours of credit from a two-year college toward the completion of a four-year program of study. Only courses with a grade of C- or above will be accepted for transfer credit. Students must also complete a minimum of 30 hours at CUNE with a minimum of 12 hours completed at the 300 or 400 level. A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with total hours required varying by major. Specific graduation requirements can be found in the Undergraduate Catalog.
