## BENEFITS FOR YOUR STUDENTS

- 1 Increased likelihood of matriculating in college and graduating within four years
- 2 Flexible college options: early graduation, double majors, employment, extracurricular activities

## SCHOOL BENEFITS COURSE STIPEND

Schools receive a \$560 stipend per course.

## CONTINUING EDUCATION SUPPORT

**Graduate Tuition Waiver:** Schools receive a Concordia Nebraska graduate course waiver for every 50 credits of student registrations.

**Subject Area Mastery Scholarships:** Concordia provides scholarships up to \$300/credit for teachers to earn the requisite graduate hours to offer dual credit in their content area.

## LIBRARY RESOURCES

Partner schools receive free access to Concordia's online research library.

## REQUIREMENTS

### STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- Juniors/seniors: 3.0 GPA automatic, or 2.50-2.99 GPA with parent permission
- Freshmen/sophomores: 3.0 GPA, parent permission, and administrative approval

### FACULTY ELIGIBILITY

- Master's degree in the field
- Any Master's degree plus 18 graduate hours in the field, including content-area methods courses
- Tested experience or industry certifications in foreign language and professional/technical fields
