

Graduate Tuition Waiver Policy for Dual Credit Instructors and Schools

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for granting three (3) credit hour graduate tuition waivers (course waivers) to schools and teachers who partner with Concordia University, Nebraska (CUNE) to provide quality undergraduate instruction to high school students enrolled in CUNE courses.

REQUIREMENTS:

Dual Credit – School

The CUNE Dual Credit Program will grant a cooperating school one (1) course waiver for every 50 undergraduate credits registered by students from the cooperating school.

A course waiver shall:

- Be available for use during the next two (2) academic years (July 1 to June 30) after the date of grant.
- Be transferable within a school district upon approval of school administration.
- Be limited to teaching staff of the school.
- Be limited to use in CUNE or Concordia Online Education graduate programs only.

Course availability during an academic year will be identified by the start date of the course.

There is a limit of six (6) credits of waivers per student per academic year from all CUNE sources (e.g., student teaching and dual credit).

Tuition waivers offered pursuant to this policy are at the sole discretion of CUNE and may be discontinued at any time.
