Course Transfer Guide for Programs



The following list provides course equivalents between Concordia University, Nebraska and Central Community College in the programs of Behavioral Science, Business Administration and Education.

Transfer students must be in good standing and have a 2.00 or higher grade point average from Central Community College. Concordia University, Nebraska accepts up to 70 hours of credit from a two-year college toward the completion of a four-year program of studies. Only courses with a grade of C- or above will be accepted for transfer credit. Students must also complete a minimum of 30 hours at CUNE with a minimum of 12 hours at the 300 or 400 level.

Students who have completed an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science at Central Community College shall be considered to have completed all general education requirements except for religion and theology.
