MEET THE TOP DOG: HEAD COACH LARRY OETTING



Back for his thirteenth year on the gridiron staff and fifth year as head coach is Dr. Larry Oetting. Larry is a 1962 alumnus of Concordia and taught at Brentwood, MO, and Mt. Clemens, MI, before returning to CTC. He received his master's degree in physical education at Wayne University in Detroit and his Ph.D. in Educational Psychology at the University of Nebraska, Lincoln. As a player at Concordia, Oetting started for four years and won All-Conference and Little All-American Awards.

In addition, Dr. Oetting was a member of the Pontiac Arrows, a semi-professional football team from Pontiac, MI, in 1965 and 1966. After returning to Concordia, Oetting's coaching responsibilities were split between assisting in football and head track coach. His track program produced several NAIA All-Americans as well as a Tri-State Conference championship in the last year Concordia was a member of that conference.

Larry and his wife Kitty (Gross) have three children, Jonathan, Daniel, and Sara.

COURTNEY MEYER. Courtney Meyer assumed defensive coordinator responsibilities in 1978. Courtney returned to the Concordia coaching staff in 1977. Previously he had served on the coaching staff in 1970-71 when he was a graduate assistant at Concordia. A 1965 Concordia alumnus, Meyer lettered in both football and baseball, and was named Outstanding Senior Athlete. He has taught at Lutheran high schools in Maspeth, New York, Brookville, Long Island, New York, and Mayer, Minnesota. At Mayer he coached football, JV basketball, track, and girls' basketball, and holds an overall coaching record of 11 conference championships in 13 varsity seasons.

Courtney received the M.A. degree in Physical Education from Southeast Missouri State University at Cape Girardeau. In addition to his coaching duties, he is a Concordia admissions counselor.

STEVE SIREK. Steve Sirek will coordinate the offense and be primarily responsible for the backs. His area of responsibility will be with the receivers. Steve returned to Concordia as a coach and half time instructor in 1978 after farming for several years. He since has accepted a full time position in Concordia's Student Life Office, and assistant football and head baseball coach.

Sirek played four years at Concordia and developed into an outstanding defensive back. He graduated in 1972 and continued as a graduate assistant for one year. He then taught and was the head football coach at Lutheran High School South in St. Louis, Missouri.

Sirek received his M.A. degree in Physical Education at the University of Nebraska in 1979. Steve's wife Kathy (Kamprath) also graduated from Concordia and is employed at Concordia. Their daughter, Christiana, was born in December, 1979.

DEAN VIESELMAYER. Dean Vieselmeyer will coordinate the defensive line and linebacker positions and be responsible for the kicking game. He continues as Concordia's strength coach. Dean returned to Concordia as an instructor and coach in 1977. A 1970 graduate of Concordia, Vieselmeyer was an outstanding offensive lineman during his student days. He continued his education and received the Master of Divinity degree from Concordia Theological Seminary in Springfield, Illinois, in 1974. Rev. Vieselmeyer then taught at Milwaukee Lutheran High School for three years where he coached football, wrestling, track, and established an outstanding weight lifting program.

Dean and his wife Dian (Lofing) have two sons, Brent and Brad.

RANDY KRIEGER. Randy Krieger, upon using up his football eligibility last year, has joined the coaching staff in 1981 while he continues his studies towards dual certification in the area of mathematics. He will be in charge of receivers.

LEE VIESELMAYER. Lee Vieselmeyer returns for his fourth year on Concordia's staff. His primary responsibility is with the defensive line. Lee played outstanding ball at Concordia as a defensive tackle in 1969 and 1970. He then transferred to the University of Nebraska and earned a degree in Agronomy. He is presently self employed with business interest in Davenport, Nebraska, as well as in Seward.

CASEY VREELAND. Casey Vreeland completed his playing career as a defensive and offensive lineman in 1978. Casey was the head scout coach and assisted the defensive line coach in 1979. He will be an offensive line coach and scout coach and will work fulltime while attending classes part time.

BULLDOG SENIORS



Jim Beaudoin - Quick and aggressive four year starter as defensive cornerback. Jim is a "Super" senior, actually playing in his sophomore year and received an additional year in eligibility because of a hardship ruling. Beaudoin plans on teaching and coaching in a Lutheran high school.



Tom Kelzer - Captain and four year starter as linebacker who has improved each season. Tom is quick, aggressive, and effective against the run or pass.



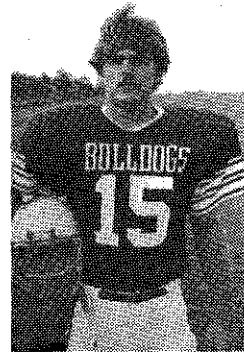
John Dumar - Has been the bulldog kicker for four years. John holds the school record for the longest field goal (46 yards) and most field goals per season (5).
